What is the most frequent cause of disability?



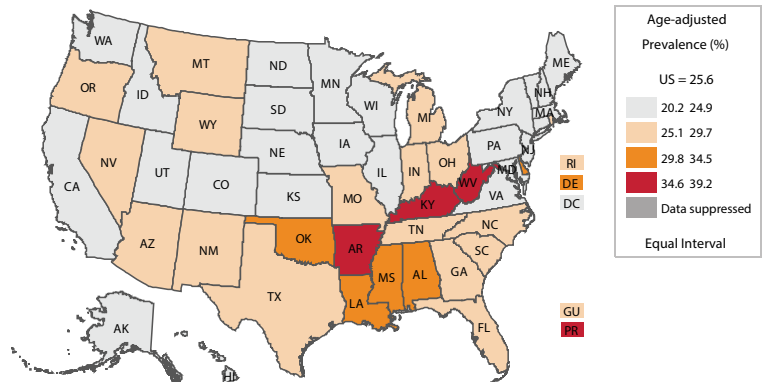
Arthritis is a leading cause of disability among adults.
